History

AEP Ohio serves nearly 1.5 million customers in Ohio, providing power to more than 920 communities located in 61 of the state’s 88 counties. Problem/Issue

An AEP representative contacted a Flow-Liner Installer looking for a solution to repair a 10” storm pipe in the basement of their facility located in Columbus, Ohio. The 10” storm pipe, approximately 116’, had some cracks in it and it was leaking whenever it rained. To complicate matters, the 10” storm pipe was located in the ceiling above several conduits and other piping, making access to the pipe difficult.

Solution

Using Flow-Liner® technology, a Flow-Liner Certified Installer prepared and installed the “Flow-Liner® Cured-In-Place Pipe Lining System” in the 10” storm pipe.

Results

The 10” storm pipe was successfully lined without demolition or disruption to the occupied office spaces at the AEP facility. The Building Operations Manager of the AEP facility was very pleased with the results and commented:

“They did a great job for us in a timely manner. The pipe lining saved us from having to tear out a 100’ of ceiling to replace the piping (which was also over many conduits) which would have been very costly and inconvenient.”
